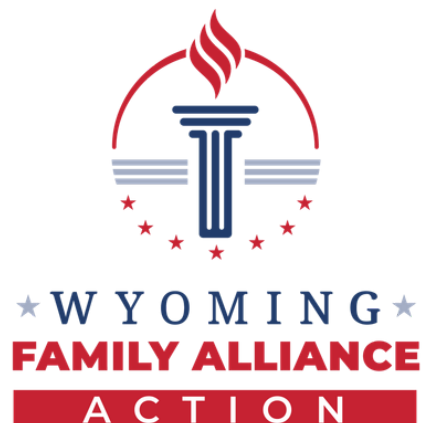

About This Guide

WyoVoterGuide.com compiles publicly verifiable candidate endorsements from organizations and notable individuals that help Wyoming voters understand a candidate's worldview and governance philosophy. We include only entities legally permitted to endorse (PACs, 501(c)(4) organizations, and individuals; never 501(c)(3)s or unregistered groups). Party committees and purely commercial or industry endorsements are outside our scope. Ratings, donations, questionnaire scores, and event appearances are not endorsements. Endorsements by named individuals are matters of public record and reflect the personal views of those individuals only, including where an individual also serves with a church, a civic organization, or Wyoming Family Alliance itself. No listing in this guide is an endorsement by any organization the individual serves, nor by this guide, which endorses no one.

How this guide was compiled

- Every endorsement in this guide is verified against a public source: an official organization release or published guide (Grade A) or the candidate's own campaign materials quoting the organization (Grade B). Candidate-reported claims without confirmation are not published.
- The perceived-lean labels describe how each organization is generally characterized in public coverage; they are informational, not editorial judgments by Wyoming Family Alliance Action.
- An organization's absence from this guide does not mean it made no endorsements; it means no qualifying, verifiable public endorsement was located by the verification date. Verify late changes before printing or broad distribution.
- Legislative Record scores are explained in the introduction to the Candidate Index. They are drawn from the roll-call votes published in WyoVoterGuide's 2024–2026 Roll Call Votes resources, where the full bill list and every individual vote are posted.

Candidate Index

This index lists every candidate for federal and statewide office, together with every legislative candidate who holds at least one verified public endorsement, organized by race from the highest office down, with candidates alphabetized by last name within each race, with the organizations and named individuals standing behind them.

The Legislative Record column reflects the research this guide is built on, organized around Wyoming Family Alliance's four main areas of advocacy: Sanctity of Life, Religious Liberty, Family Values, and Education Freedom.

Each year, WFA monitors legislation related to these four areas during Wyoming's legislative session. The progress of these bills is documented on WyoFamBillTracker.com, including every roll call vote. WyoVoterGuide.com's Roll Call resource page highlights bills that either passed or progressed enough to significantly demonstrate each legislator's voting tendencies.

For candidates who served in the Wyoming Legislature during the 2024, 2025, or 2026 sessions, the bold text in the Legislative Record column shows how often their votes aligned with those priorities overall, followed by their alignment in each of the four areas. For example, 22 of 28, or 79%, means alignment on 22 of the 28 bills on which that legislator cast a countable vote. Each bill counts once; the final vote on a bill governs, and excused votes are not counted. A dash means the candidate did not serve in the Legislature during those sessions, so no score exists; it is not a zero.
